புற்றுநோய் கட்டி பரவியிருந்த முழங்கால் மூட்டு முழுமையாக அகற்றப்பட்டு நவீன முறையில் செயற்கை மூட்டு மாற்றப்பட்டது. அதே வேளையில் லேப்ரால்கோபி ரோடிக்கல் நெப்ரெக்டோமி எனப்படும் அதிநவீன தொழில்நுட்பத்தில் பாதிக்கப்பட்ட சிறுநீரகமும் அகற்றப்பட்டது. அடி வயிற்றில் 5 மில்லி மீட்டர் அளவில் துளைகளிடப்பட்டு அந்த சிகிச்சை மேற்கொள்ளப்பட்டது.

India mulls new AI based policy on security threats

PM holds meet with key ministers & officials

New Delhi, June 30: Expeditious framing of a broad-based policy to deal with emerging security threats and futuristic challenges facing the country was a major focus of a meeting Prime Minister Narendra Modi held with Home Minister Amit Shah, Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and National Security Advisor Ajit Doval on Tuesday, people familiar with the development said.

The meeting took place two days after explosives-laden drones were used to carry out an attack on the Jammu Air Force station in the first such instance of suspected Pakistan-based terrorists deploying unmanned aerial vehicles to strike at vital installations.

“The government is coming out with a policy to collectively deal with the emerging challenges. It was decided to expedite the framing of the policy,” one of the sources cited above said after the meeting.

Various ministries and departments are working on the policy to effectively counter the new and emerging non-traditional

security challenges facing the country.

The Defence Ministry and the three services will play a leading role in the formulation of the policy as well as in its implementation by coordinating with all the leading stakeholders and security agencies.

It has also been learnt that the three forces are being told to adequately focus on bridging the gaps in effectively dealing with new-age challenges such as drone attacks and go for the procurement of the necessary hardware to contain those.

The meeting also discussed various other aspects, including equipping the security forces with modern equipment and involving more youngsters, start-ups and the strategic community in the field.

The Army has already been working on incorporating artificial intelligence, cognitive sciences, robotics, drones, quantum computing, nanotechnology and cyber capabilities as part of the efforts to deal with future challenges.

The sources said the three services as well

as key national security planners will have a series of meetings in the next few weeks and months to speed up the work on the policy. The Defence Research and Development Organisation

(DRDO) has developed anti-drone technology to shoot down hostile drones in the range of two to three kilometres. It is expected to conduct more research on extending the range.

Gen Rawat visits forward posts

Six naval conventional submarines

Sir,

It is heartening to note that one of the largest ‘Make in India’ projects in the Naval sector the Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) on 04-06-2021 approved a request for proposal (RFP) to build six conventional submarines at an estimated cost of Rs.43000 crores. The project will be under the strategic partnership model P75(1) which means the whole process will be led by an Indian Manufacturer.

The submarines will be equipped with the State of the art Air Independent propulsion system; the defence ministry said. The DAC was chaired by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.

On January 2020 two domestic ship yard companies- State owned Mazagon Dock Ship builders Ltd (MDL) and private sector firm Larsen Toubro (L&T) were identified as strategic partners for the P75 (I) programme.


These two strategic partners will now get the RFP in about a month and do the legwork, including scouting for Global Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) to provide various systems. They will submit their project reports in three months, after which their technical evaluation will be done and oneship builder picked.

Contract signing can happen by 2022 end assuming the projects is on the fast track. The chosen company will then begin building infrastructure with Central funds. The selected OEMs will transfer technology and train personnel, after which manufacturing will begin. It is a 30 year project and its first submarine ought to be ready in about 10 years.

“It will be a strategic shift in overall capability building towards manufacturing of complex systems”.

The DAC also approved Armys’ Rs. 6000 cr plan to procure air defence guns and ammunition under the Buy and Make Indian Category.

Some athletes cut out to scale Himalayan heights

Will pandemic-scarred Tokyo throw up new star?

The 32nd Summer Olympics will finally kickstart on July 23 in Tokyo. The event earlier scheduled to be held in 2020 was postponed due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic that shattered the world order. With the threat of COVID-19 still looming large, Japan is backing off a forecast of how many gold medals it will win at the pandemic-delayed Tokyo Olympics that are set to open next month. In fact, Japanese Prime Minister Yoshihide Suga and the International Olympic Committee seem to be hellbent on beating the COVID-19 blues by insisting on hosting the mega event under a new normal despite a vast majority of Japanese citizens being sceptical about the conduct of the games.

The Japanese Olympic Committee said 30 gold medals was their earlier target which was set much before the pandemic hit. The president of the Japanese Olympic Committee now says that is no longer the goal. Predicting performance in Tokyo could be a problem for many countries, not only Japan.

The United States and China are predicted to finish first and second in the gold-medal standings, as they did in Rio and London. China topped the United States in the gold-medal tally at the 2008 Beijing Olympics.

Japan was aiming very high

looking for 30 gold.

In Rio de Janeiro, Japan won 12 gold medals, and its best was 16 in 2004 at Athens and in 1964 when Tokyo was also the venue.

This time Japan is relying on seven core sports swimming, judo, badminton, track and field, gymnastics, table tennis, and wrestling. It will also hope to score in the five sports added for Tokyo: baseball, softball, sports climbing, karate, and skate boarding.

Let us also watch out for Olympian efforts from individual sportsmen.

While uncertainty seems to be the only certainty in the present times, there is always hope that better days will prevail as the cliched saying goes “there will be light at the end of the dark tunnel” or “every night will be followed by a day”.

Irrespective of what happens in

the future, the past has a great history of Olympic records and performances. Over the years, many athletes have scaled Herculean heights to leave behind vestiges of legendary moments to fall back on. Will Olympics 2020 throw up such a legend, only time will tell!

Steve Redgrave, the awesome oarsman from the UK. His famous quote “...diabetes had to live with me, not me live with it...”

Redgrave had, at the age of 34, won the rowing gold for the fourth Games in a row and on live TV, he announced his retirement in unequivocal fashion. Yet four years later - after being diagnosed with Type 2 diabetes in 1997, and suffering with debilitating ulcerative colitis since before the 1992 Barcelona Games - he put his ailing, 38-year-old body through a punishing training regime one last time and achieved another Olympic triumph, as a member of the coxless fours.

In doing so Redgrave became the only endurance sport athlete to win five golds in five consecutive Games: 1984 (coxed fours), 1988, 1992, 1996 (coxless pairs) and 2000 (coxless fours). His secret?

“I decided that diabetes had to live with me, not me live with it,” he said.

Nirav files fresh plea in UK court against extradition

London, June 30: Wanted diamond merchant Nirav Modi on Tuesday renewed his appeal in the High Court in London against being extradited to India to face charges of fraud and money laundering in the estimated \$ 2-billion Punjab National Bank (PNB) scam case.

The 50-year-old jeweller, who remains behind bars at Wandsworth Prison in south-west London, had lost the first stage of the High Court appeals process last week as a judge declined permission to appeal “on the papers”.

Modi's lawyers had five days to file a renewal application seeking an oral hearing to plead the case for permission to appeal against the extradition ordered by UK Home Secretary Priti Patel on April 16. “A renewal hearing is listed for 21 July 2021,” a court official confirmed on Tuesday. At the brief hearing next month, a High Court judge will determine if there are any grounds for an appeal against the Home Secretary's decision or the Westminster Magistrates Court February ruling in favour of Modi's extradition to India for the case.
