

Uncertainty looms over elections results

Trump, Biden gear for protracted legal battle

Washington, Nov. 5: The race for the White House appears to be headed towards an uncharted territory with the Trump and Biden campaigns gearing up for a protracted legal battle in the US Supreme Court as the election results in some of the key battleground states like Pennsylvania, Wisconsin and Michigan still being counted.

All eyes are now on Pennsylvania, Michigan, Wisconsin, Nevada, North Carolina and Georgia. Counting of mail-in-ballots, which was voted in record numbers this time, might take time.

Officials in Pennsylvania said on Wednesday that they expect all votes to be counted by Friday. The Biden campaign believes that they have a definitive edge on this, while the Trump campaign fears that there could be electoral malpractice during the counting of votes.

We want the law to be used in a proper manner so we'll be going to the US Supreme Court. We want all voting to stop. We don't want them to find any ballots at 4:00 in the morning, President Donald Trump said to his supporters at the White House in the wee hours of Wednesday.

Earlier, Trump claimed victory in the election and called it "a fraud on the American public" and said, "Frankly, we did win this election." He also said he planned to take the battle to the Supreme Court to stop the counting of votes.

"All of a sudden everything just stopped. This is a fraud on the American public. This is an embarrassment to our country. We were getting ready to win this election. Frankly, we did win this election," Trump said, without citing any evidence of a fraud in the electoral process.

According to latest projections, Trump is set to win 213 electoral college votes while his Democratic rival Joe Biden is projected to have taken a lead with 238 electoral college votes. Either of them needs at least 270 electoral college votes to be declared as the winner. Counting of votes have resumed in the battleground states.

In his brief remarks in Delaware, Biden said, We knew because of the unprecedented early vote and the mail in vote that it's gonna take a while. We're gonna have to be patient until we--the hard work of tallying votes is finished. And it ain't over till every vote is counted. Every ballot is counted. Biden said.

Both the sides firmly believe that they are the winner.

I'm here to tell you tonight, we believe we're on track to win this election, Biden said.

A celebration without victory as 2020 race dangles

Washington, Nov. 5: It was a victory celebration without a victory.

Empty wine glasses littered a table in the East Room of the White House. Pizza boxes and cans of White Claw hard seltzer abounded elsewhere in the complex.

As Election Day came and went without a verdict in the presidential race, President Donald Trump grew agitated. At 2:21 a.m., the president took the stage before a well-lubricated crowd in the East Room and falsely claimed he had won. He vowed to take his case to the Supreme Court.

"We were getting ready for a big celebration, Trump said. We were winning everything and all of the sudden it was just called off.

He added, We will win this and as far as I'm concerned we already have won it. That was not true. Biden, too, felt the need to respond to the indecision. Just after midnight, the former vice president's motorcade abruptly shuttled him from his house in Wilmington, Delaware, to an outdoor speaking venue nearby, where he cautioned that a result might not come for a few days.

We're going to have to be patient, Biden said around 12:30 a.m., as supporters honked their car horns to signal their assent. It ain't over until every vote is counted.

The drama in the wee hours of Wednesday stood in stark contrast to the candidates' more valedictory tones on Election Day.

US formally exits Paris climate deal amid poll chaos

United Nations, Nov. 5: The US formally exited the Paris Climate Agreement on Wednesday amid election uncertainty, three years after President Donald Trump announced his intent to remove the country from participating in the landmark global pact to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

President Trump originally announced his intention to withdraw from the agreement in 2017 and formally notified the United Nations last year.

The US exited the pact after a mandatory year-long waiting period that ended on Wednesday.

The official withdrawal from the Paris Climate Accord comes as the US is in the middle of a tight Presidential election, with the race to the White House between President Donald Trump and his Democratic rival Joe Biden poised for a photo-finish with million of votes still being counted.

The US had signed the Paris Agreement on April 22, 2016 and expressed

its consent to be bound by the Agreement by acceptance in September 2016.

A letter to the Secretary-General from US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, dated November 4, 2019 said, this letter constitutes notification by the United States of America of its withdrawal from the Paris Agreement. Pursuant to Article 28, paragraph 2, of the Paris Agreement, the withdrawal of the United States from the Paris Agreement shall take effect upon expiry of one year from the date on which you receive this notification of withdrawal.

The historic accord seeks to limit global warming to less than 2 degrees Celsius, the value that climate scientists have determined will have disastrous consequences if exceeded.

Trump has repeatedly criticised the agreement as economically detrimental and claimed it could cost the country 2.5 million jobs by 2025.

He also said it gave other major emitters, like China and India, a free

pass. The US is the only country to withdraw from the global pact. It can still attend negotiations and give opinions, but is relegated to observer status.

Trump stated that he intended to renegotiate the details of the United States' membership within the Paris Agreement that can better protect US workers in industries like coal, paper, and steel.

UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres had earlier called the decision by the US to withdraw from the Paris Agreement on climate change as a major disappointment for global efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and promote global security.

The Paris Agreement was adopted by all the world's nations in 2015 because they recognise the immense harm that climate change is already causing and the enormous opportunity that climate action presents. It offers a meaningful yet flexible framework for action by all countries, Guterres had said.

3 more Rafale jets arrive non-stop from France

New Delhi, Nov. 5: A second batch of three Rafale fighter jets arrived at Jamnagar airbase in Gujarat on Wednesday evening after flying non-stop from France, in a further boost to the strike capability of the Indian Air Force when India and China are locked in a bitter border row in eastern Ladakh.

The IAF said the three aircraft got airborne from Istres airbase in France and flew for over eight hours covering over 3,700 nautical miles before landing in India.

With the arrival of the new batch, the number of Rafale aircraft has increased to eight.

The first batch of five Rafale jets arrived in India on July 29, nearly four years after India signed an inter-governmental agreement with France to procure 36 aircraft at a cost of Rs 59,000 crore.

"Second batch of IAF #Rafale aircraft arrived in India at 8:14 pm on 04 Nov 20 after flying non-stop from France," the IAF said in a tweet.

Officials said the new batch comprised three jets.

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh's office said he congratulated the IAF for successfully accomplishing a "highly complex mission" in a professional and safe manner.

"The second batch of three Rafale

aircraft got airborne from Istres airbase in France and flew for over eight hours before landing at an IAF base. They covered a distance of over 3700 nautical miles with three in-flight refuellings," the IAF said in another tweet.

The Rafale jets, manufactured by French aerospace major Dassault Aviation, are India's first major acquisition of fighter planes in 23 years after the Sukhoi jets were imported from Russia.

The newly inducted fleet of five Rafale jets has been carrying out sorties in eastern Ladakh.

The IAF has deployed almost all its frontline fighter jets like Sukhoi 30 MKI, Jaguar and Mirage 2000 aircraft in the key frontier air bases in eastern Ladakh and elsewhere along the LAC.

Chief of Air Staff Air Chief Marshal RKS Bhaduria on October 5 said that the induction of all 36 Rafale jets will be completed by 2023.

The Rafale jets are capable of carrying a range of potent weapons. European missile maker MBDA's Meteor beyond visual range air-to-air missile, Scalp cruise missile and MICA weapons system will be the mainstay of the weapons package of the Rafale jets.

The IAF is also procuring a new generation medium-range modular air-to-ground weapon system Hammer to integrate with the Rafale jets.

Trump Jr paints J&K, North-East red in inaccurate map

New York, Nov. 5: Donald Trump Jr, son of US President Donald Trump, drew flak and criticism on Wednesday for posting an inaccurate world map drenched in the red colour of the Republican Party and one which showed the whole of India as blue, the colour of the Democratic Party, with the exception of Kashmir and North-East states.

"Okay, finally got around to making my electoral map prediction," Trump Jr said in a Twitter post along with the world map on Tuesday as the US began voting in the 2020 presidential election, implying that the entire world is voting for and supporting his father and the Republican Party.

The map showed all the countries, including water bodies and Antarctica, coloured red,

with the exception of the state of California, India, Mexico, Liberia, Cuba and China coloured blue - the hue of the Democratic party. However, while India was coloured blue, Jammu and Kashmir and the North-East states were coloured red. The Indian borders were also inaccurate in the map.

Trump Jr drew flak on social media for the tweet and for showing Kashmir and the North-East states in a colour different from the rest of India.

"So much for the friendship with Trump Senior. Junior has placed India firmly with @JoeBiden & @KamalaHarris though interestingly Jr. believes J&K & the NorthEast go against the rest of India & will vote Trump. Someone needs to take his colouring pencils away," former Chief

Minister of Jammu and Kashmir Omar Abdullah tweeted.

Congress leader Shashi Tharoor tweeted, "The price of Nam's bromance: Kashmir & the NorthEast cut off from the rest of India, & the whole filthy" place relegated by Don Jr to the realm of hostiles, along with China & Mexico. So much for the crores spent on obsequious serenading stadium events! Senior Fellow and Director of the Middle East Security Program at the Centre for a New American Security Ilan Goldenberg tweeted, I'm pretty sure Don Jr. confused Iran and India on a world map. That's my theory and I'm sticking to it.

Democratic nominee from New York Jamaal Bowman tweeted, "Fully fund Social Studies. This is a mess."

Mainstream American media reported that it might take days before the winner is known.

A sense of uncertainty and fear crept into the minds of voters on either side of the political divide, The Wall Street Journal reported.

The morning after a chaotic, suspenseful Election Day, Americans awoke on Wednesday to the spectre of hours or even days of uncertainty ahead, as several states counted millions of ballots in razor-thin contests that could tip the balance to President Trump or former Vice President Joseph R. Biden Jr, The New York Times reported.

The nation awoke to uncertainty Wednesday, with no winner in the bitter presidential contest. Democratic nominee Joe Biden urged patience even as President Trump prematurely declared victory before millions of votes were counted in key states, The Washington Post reported.

Democrats, the

newspaper said, failed to reap the decisive national repudiation of Trump that Biden had sought, arguing that the president has mismanaged the deadly coronavirus pandemic and cleaved the country with racially divisive rhetoric. Democrats also sustained unexpected losses to their majority in the House and faced diminished prospects to take control of the Senate, despite expectations, it said.

The Washington Post alleged that Trump broke democratic norms by asserting that he had already won, despite the paths to victory that remain for Biden.

He claimed he will ask the Supreme Court to intervene in the election process, saying that voting must stop and falsely claiming that by continuing to count votes already cast, the Democrats would be stealing the election. Polls have closed, and no more votes are being cast, only tallied, the daily said.

MPs nod for UK lockdown

England will enter a second stay-at-home lockdown from Thursday until at least December 2 as members of Parliament approved the new shutdown, announced last week by UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson in an attempt to curb the spike in coronavirus infections in the country. In a House of Commons vote on Wednesday, the parliamentarians supported the new measures by 516 to 38, a majority of 478.

It means that, from one minute past midnight on Wednesday, pubs, bars, restaurants and non-essential shops will close across England and stay shut until the rule expires on December 2. It will replace the three-tiers of regional restrictions across England for four weeks, after which the tiers will be re-imposed. A total of 34 members of Parliament from Boris Johnson's ruling Conservative Party rebelled against the lockdown, including former Conservative leader Sir Iain Duncan Smith and Sir Graham Brady, the chair of the powerful 1922 Committee of Tory backbenchers.

Nepal cases on the rise

Nepal has reported 3,309 new cases of coronavirus, taking the total number of infections in the nation to 182,923, the health ministry said on Wednesday. Ministry of Health and Population said the new cases were detected while conducting 12,144 polymerase chain reaction (PCR) tests at various labs across the country in the past 24 hours. Nepal has recorded 3,309 new cases of novel coronavirus infections in the past 24 hours taking the country's COVID-19 tally to 182,923. Kathmandu Valley alone witnessed 1,878 new cases of coronavirus in the last one day, the ministry said in a statement. Dr. Jageshwar Gautam, spokesperson for the Ministry of Health and Population, 3,844 persons, who had earlier tested positive for coronavirus, have been discharged after their recovery in the past 24 hours taking the COVID-19 recovery tally to 144,978. There are currently 36,911 coronavirus active patients undergoing treatment at various isolation centres across the country, he said.
